

WASHING LIST

Everything is machine wash, machine dry unless specified otherwise.

Every day:

- White a-tanks
- Tights in laundry bag
- Socks in laundry bag
- Mic Belts if in laundry bag
- Bras and shapewear (hang dry)

Every Sunday take the following to wash:

- Skid row urchin costumes
- Bras
- Dress shirts
- All skins
- Bathroom towels (and other towels that seem gross)

Specific Costume Pieces:

- Denea: Stripe top (attached to skirt) is dyed. Delicates or hand wash, hang dry. Wash separately.
- Elexis: Purple polka dot top is dyed. Hand wash, hang dry.
- Crystal: Denim shorts are dyed. Hand wash, hang dry.
- Lauren: Pink dance briefs. Hand wash, hand dry.
- Lauren: Polka dot dress, black and plaid dress, pink cheetah print dress. Gentle cycle/hand wash, hang dry.
- Michael: Mint green socks. Hand wash, hang dry.
- Kelly: Sweater and sweater vest. Gentle cycle, and lay flat to dry (on sweater rack).
- Allen: Stained yellow shirt is dyed. Hand wash or wash with winos, hang dry or tumble dry with winos.
- Andrew: Turtleneck sweater. Gentle cycle, and lay flat to dry (on sweater rack).
- Winos: All costume pieces dyed or treated, can wash together.
- Prologue for Doo-Wap Girls: Hand wash gentle. Hang dry by hanging loops only. Must have 24 hours to dry. Must be under a fan. Only if really gross.
- The Meek Girls: Remove tulle layers, hand wash sequin layers. Hang dry by hanging loops only. Must have 24 hours to dry. Must be under a fan. Only if really gross.
- Finale for Doo-Wap Girls: Hand wash gentle. Hang dry by hanging loops only. Must have 24 hours to dry. Must be under a fan. Only if really gross.

If you want to wash it, just ask. I'll let you know if it's dry clean only or not.
